Road Work in Centre County to Continue Next Week

State College, PA – As work to improve more than 41 miles of roadway in Centre and Clinton counties continues, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is issuing an update on its project schedule. Overall work includes milling, base repair, resurfacing, curbing, sidewalks, and guide rail updates on sections of seven routes in Centre County and five routes in Clinton County.

In Centre County, work through July 11 includes:

- Monday, July 9, the contractor will complete micro-surfacing operations on Route 45 from the Huntingdon County line to Pine Grove Mills. Drivers should anticipate delays and allow for extra travel time.
- Tuesday, July 10 through Wednesday, July 11, the contractor will be engaged in micro-surfacing operations on Route 550 from Carson's Corner to Route 3002 (Bernel Road). Drivers should plan for delays and allow for extra travel time.

Alternating traffic patterns will be in place for this work zone, controlled by flaggers in the roadway. Travel delays should be expected and drivers should be alert for slow moving and stopped vehicles through the work zone. All work is weather and schedule dependent.

No work is scheduled for next week in Clinton County.

Glenn O. Hawbaker Inc. is the contractor on this \$6.8 million project, which is expected to finish by late October. PennDOT will issue updates on this project as work locations change.

Other roads on this project in Centre County include Route 26 from East Calder Way to Elmwood Street, Route 45 from the Huntingdon County line to Pine Grove Mills, Route 1001 (Howard Divide Road) from Howard to Marsh Creek, Route 3029 (Ninth Street) in Philipsburg from the Ninth Street bridge to Route 53, and Route 3042 Skytop Mountain Road) from Laurel Run to Port Matilda.

Roads on this project in Clinton County include Route 44 from the Route 220 interchange to the Lycoming County line, Route 1001 (Farrandsville Road) from Lock Haven to State Game Lands Road, Route 1016 (Avis Road) from Avis to Pine Creek, and Route 1022 (Pine Creek Road) from Route 1016 to the Route 220 interchange.

PennDOT reminds drivers to be cautious in work zones, obey posted speed limits, and always buckle up.

Motorists can check conditions on more than 40,000 roadway miles by visiting www.511PA.com. 511PA is free, available 24 hours a day, and provides traffic delay warnings, weather forecasts, traffic speed information, and access to more than 860 traffic cameras.
