Patton Township Prepares for Winter Storm

The Patton Township Police Department would like to remind Patton Township residents about snow parking regulations. On-street parking is prohibited if a snow emergency has been declared or if the snowfall has reached or exceeded two inches. Re-parking after the snow shall be unlawful until the snow emergency has ended or until snow plows have cleared your street. Vehicles found in violation will be ticketed and fined \$15.00.

Residents are also reminded that they must clear the full width of their sidewalks of all snow and ice within 24 hours after the end of a storm. Ordinance violation notices along with a \$15.00 fine will be issued to properties that fail to comply with this regulation.

The Patton Township Police Department would like to thank all township residents for their cooperation. This will ensure that our roadways can be properly cleared and pedestrians can safely walk on the sidewalks within the Township.
