

PUBLIC WORKS FAQs

Q: Does the Township provide compost and mulch for residents?

A: Compost is not available at the Township facility, but both compost and mulch are available at the Glenn O. Hawbaker Recycle Center. This facility is located at 110 Hawbaker Industrial Drive, which is the former State College Borough Compost Facility. The Hawbaker Recycle Center is open Monday through Friday from 8 am to 4 pm and Saturdays from 8 am to noon. Compost and mulch can be purchased any time that the Recycle Center is open. If individuals need additional information, the telephone number for the Recycle Center is 814-272-0008.

Q: Where can I take my leaves and brush?.

A: The Township's Public Works Department has collections throughout the year (See the Leaf & Brush Calendar on the Public Works page of this website for more details). Also the Township collects leaves and brush on the first Monday of each month that is not a holiday. See the Public Works page for leaf and brush collection guidelines.

Q: Where can I take my grass clippings?

A: Patton Township residents may now dispose of their grass clippings, free of charge, at the Glenn O. Hawbaker Recycle Center/State College Borough Compost Facility located at 110 Hawbaker Industrial Drive. The site is located behind the Fairfield Inn and Suites on North Atherton Street. Grass clippings may be dropped off any time that the center is open (Monday through Friday, 8am to 5pm / Saturdays, 9am-12pm).
