Google Fiber for Communities

Google is planning to launch an experiment that it hopes will make Internet access better and faster for everyone. It plans to test ultra-high speed broadband networks in one or more trial locations across the country. Its networks will deliver Internet speeds more than 100 times faster than what most Americans have access to today, over 1 gigabit per second, fiber-to-the-home connections. It plans to offer service at a competitive price to at least 50,000 and potentially up to 500,000 people.

From now until March 26th, Google has asked interested municipalities to provide them with information about their communities through a Request for information (RFI), which it will use to determine where to build this new ultra-high speed network.
