Our agenda for the Committee meeting on Tuesday, February 15, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. is as follows:

1. CALL TO ORDER

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Enclosed are the minutes from the January Recreation Advisory Committee, which should be reviewed and accepted.

3. ADDITIONS TO THE POSTED AGENDA

At this time, the Chair may announce and/or ask the Committee members for the addition of agenda items that are not already on the agenda.

Any Committee member wishing to add an item to the agenda shall ask for recognition by the Chair and shall make a motion to add an item, including stating the nature of the item and reason for changing the agenda. If the motion is seconded, the Chair shall oversee discussion and a vote on the motion to add the item. If the motion is approved by a majority vote of the individuals present and voting, the item shall be added to the agenda. The Chair shall determine the placement of the added item within the meeting agenda.

4. GREEN HOLLOW PARK PHASE 2 ADA PATH CONSTRUCTION

YSM Landscape Architects designed Phase 2 of Green Hollow Park ADA Path project. The project went to bid through PennBid with bids due on January 12, 2022. A recommendation was made to the Board of Supervisors at their January 26, 2022 meeting and John Claar Excavating was awarded the contract. This project will begin this spring.

5. BERNEL ROAD PARK AND GREEN HOLLOW PARK COURT CONVERSIONS

The Bernel Road Park court conversion of two (2) tennis courts to six (6) pickleball courts and the Green Hollow Park court conversion from four (4) pickleball courts to two (2) tennis courts will begin this spring. A recommendation was made to the Board of Supervisors at their January 26, 2022 meeting and the project was awarded to Miller Sports Construction under the COSTARS program.

6. SCOTIA ROAD SHARED USE PATH SCOPING STUDY/ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS

Request for Proposals (RFPs) for the Scotia Road Shared Use Path Scoping Study/Alternatives Analysis were advertised and accepted through PennBid and proposals were due by 11:00 am on Monday, January 10, 2022.

Seven (7) proposals were submitted and at the January RAC meeting, the Committee decided that Wilson Consulting Group and Buchart Horn would be interviewed.

The Interview Committee was composed of Ms. Wheeler, Ms. Castrechini, Ms. Solic and Ms. Meek of the Centre Region Planning Agency.

Ms. Wheeler will provide a summary of the interviews and a summary of the projected timeline for the project. The Committee should then make a recommendation to be provided to the Board of Supervisors for their February 23, 2022 meeting.
