CRICKLEWOOD DRIVE (TOFTREES) BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS

An alternatives analysis for a bicycle/pedestrian facility along the entire length of Cricklewood Drive is underway. The overall goal of the alternatives analysis is to propose three (3) alternative designs and determine one (1) preferred design option that can be implemented to improve connectivity and safety in this area. Buchart Horn is the professional engineering design firm contracted to complete the study.

Mr. Karl Shellenberger, PE of Buchart Horn led the first public meeting for the project on January 23, 2023. After that meeting, a survey was distributed via direct notice and via the township website and social media. Fifty-seven (57) people responded to the survey. Buchart Horn has analyzed the survey data and collected additional information on existing conditions.

A summary of the design process to date and the presentation of three (3) potential alternatives will be presented by Mr. Karl Shellenberger.

The Committee should receive this information and listen to all public comments. The Committee should discuss the alternatives and may ask for additional information. No recommendation on a preferred alternative is expected from the Committee. An online survey will be made available to residents that will ask for input on the three (3) proposed alternatives after the presentation. This information will be provided to the Committee, once collected.
