Note: Criminal Arrests are the number of people arrested, not the number of charges, counts or cases cleared. These include arrests made at the time of the incident as well as those filed after an extended investigation.

Department Notes:

- A 30-year-old male was arrested for possessing a small amount of marijuana and paraphernalia. The male's vehicle was stopped for a traffic violation and the officer detected the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The male was cooperative and turned the drugs and paraphernalia over to the officer.
- A 39-year-old female was arrested for forgery, theft by deception, and identity theft. The female used our victim's information to access their bank account and remove \$5,000.
- A 62-year-old male was arrested for possessing a small amount of marijuana and paraphernalia. The male's vehicle was stopped for a traffic violation and the officers immediately detected the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The male gave officers consent to search his vehicle and the officers subsequently found the drugs and paraphernalia.
- 16 arrests were made for retail theft, 4 for minor's law and 1 for driving under the influence.
- Officers successfully served 8 warrants of the 12 warrants that they attempted to serve.
- Officers conducted 27 vacation home checks.

Use of Force: PTPD officers used force during two incidents in the month of January.

An officer was investigating a harassment report. The officer determined that he needed to arrest the female suspect by handcuffing her behind her back. The female resisted the arrest and began to physically kick the officer. The female kicked the officers body worn camera off of him. Another officer arrived and they were able to successfully handcuff the female. The female was transported to the hospital as it appeared she was suffering a mental health crisis. No injuries were reported.

Officers responded to a report that a male “cut himself and was bleeding out.” Officers made contact with the male who was intoxicated and appeared to be experiencing a mental health crisis. Officers tried to deescalate the male and gain cooperation from him but were unsuccessful. Additional officers arrived and they were able to safely handcuff the male. He then resisted walking to the waiting ambulance. Officers had to carry the male to the stretcher. The male was transported to the hospital where he was committed for a mental health evaluation. No injuries were reported.

Training and Department Activities

Ofc. Shaffer and Ofc. Tuskovich attended Tactical Response Team training.

Det. Erik Haas retired after 33 years of dedicated service to our community.

Ofc. Snyder finished up his month-long training with K9 Graf.

Sgt. Albright led our agency through another accreditation reassessment.

Ofc. Brahosky attended Crisis Intervention Team training.

Officers began yearly in-service training. This year’s topics included Legal Updates, Suicide by Cop, Community Relationships, Law Enforcement Ethics, Officer Wellness, Use of Force, and Critical Policy/Case Law Review.

Chief Jolley assisted with our accreditation reassessment, was the guest speaker at the Crisis Intervention Team training graduation, administered a promotional exam, attended a Centre Region CPR meeting, attended the Centre Region Emergency Services Group meeting, attended a Radio Advisory Board meeting, attended the Centre County Chiefs meeting, and attended the Community and Campus in Unity meeting.

I don't know if you remember me or not, [REDACTED]

I'm sorry it has taken me so long to reach out, but I wanted to send a personal message of gratitude and appreciation for the Department.

The Department responded to a 911 medical emergency cardiac arrest at my parents' home, [REDACTED] Ghaner Drive, on the morning of Tuesday, January 9, 2024.

Officer Tuscovich was the first to respond, quickly followed by Officer Sunderland and Sergeant Albright. My father suffered a cardiac arrest and they responded and worked on him until the ambulance arrived and he was transported to the hospital.

I was on an airplane to Hawaii to visit my sister and she delivered the news when I landed later that day. I immediately turned around and flew home, arriving back on Thursday, January 11, and was able to see him. My mother and I had to make some difficult decisions and he passed away in the hospital just after midnight on Friday, January 12.

It's surreal still, but I was able to see who responded prior to my arrival home on the ring door bell camera and said to my sister, "those are my guys that respond to the school."

I knew he was in the best possible hands and want to express my sincere appreciation for the work that you all do each day. Although it wasn't the outcome anyone hopes for, it gave me time to get home to support my mother in what was to come.

Please let them know that I sent this message and I certainly will tell them when I see them.

SUBJ: Performance Report

On January 9, 2024 Ofc Tuskovich, Ofc Sunderland, and Sgt Albright responded to a residence in Patton Township for a report of a male who became unresponsive after shoveling snow. Ofc Tuskovich arrived first and determined that the patient was in cardiac arrest and was not breathing and had no pulse. He immediately removed the patient from the chair he was in and placed him on the floor and began CPR. He attached an AED to the patient and administered one shock and then commenced chest compressions. Ofc Sunderland and Sgt Albright then arrived and they administered oxygen and conducted rescue breathing. EMS arrived and took over primary care but the officers continued to assist with treatment and with loading the patient onto the ambulance. The patient was breathing and had a pulse when transported from the scene and was admitted to the intensive care unit of the hospital.

It was due to the quick actions of the officers that an individual who was in cardiac arrest was revived and transported for more advanced care. Their actions reflect the highest credit on themselves and the Patton Township Police Department.

On January 18, 2024, Ofc Snyder, Ofc Vardzel, Ofc McCaslin, and Ofc Brahosky responded to a residence in Patton Township for a report of an unresponsive male. Upon arrival, the officers found the patient to still be unresponsive. They conducted an assessment of the patient and spoke to family members who were present and determined that he was likely suffering from an opioid overdose. The officers administered two doses of naloxone. The patient regained consciousness and became responsive by the time EMS personnel arrived. The patient was then transported to the hospital for more advanced care.

It was due to the quick actions of the officers that an individual who was in the advanced stages of an opioid overdose was revived and transported for more advanced care. Their actions reflect the highest credit on themselves and the Patton Township Police Department.

Patton Township Police Department Assessment Report

AGENCY PROFILE:

The Patton Township Police Department consists of twenty-one (21) full time officers, two (2) full-time civilians, and two (2) part-time civilians which are led by Chief Tyler Jolley. The Department is comprised of one the Chief of Police, three (3) Sergeants, fourteen (14) Officers and (3) Detectives. All members of the police department work eight (8) hour shifts which run from 07:00 – 15:00, 15:00 – 23:00 and 23:00-07:00. The Detectives work 08:00 – 16:00.

The agency is housed in a newer facility with plenty of room. The facility was very well thought out with Accreditation and safety in mind. Within the facility are the Chief's Office, the patrol room, detective's offices, training room, and temporary holding areas.

The evidence room was very well organized and extra security measures were followed. Within the temporary holding, audio and video surveillance were in place and there was plenty of space for the separation from sight and sound for males/female as well as adults/juveniles. Officers utilize their orange panic buttons on their radios in the event of an emergency.

The Patton Township fingerprint compliance rates are within the standard range with an average of 87.1% throughout the accreditation and the most recent quarter being 90.3%.

The Patton Township Police Department fleet consists of three (3) bicycles, two (2) Dodge Charger's, one (1) unmarked Dodge Charger, three (3) Dodge Durango's, two (2) Ford Interceptor SUV's, two (2) unmarked Ford Fusions, one (1) unmarked Honda Pilot and one (1) unmarked Ford Escape.

DEMOGRAPHICS:

The Patton Township Police Department is located in Center County, Pennsylvania. It is bordered by Hutson Township to the northwest, Benner Township to the northeast, College Township to the southeast, Ferguson Township to the south and Halfmoon Township to the southwest.

The Patton Township Police Department covers approximately 25 square miles and services approximately 16,000 residents.

As per the United States Census Bureau (2020) The Patton Township's residents were as follows:

- 75.7% non-Hispanic white
- 5.5% Hispanic or Latino
- 11.7% Asian
- 4.0% African American
- 0.3% Native American
- 0.3% Pacific Islander
- 7.9% from two or more races.

ON-SITE ASSESSMENT SUMMARY:

This was the fourth (4th) re-accreditation of the Patton Township Police Department, and it was conducted using PowerDMS. Prior to the on-site, the Assessment Team communicated via email with Chapter 1 being assigned to Assessor Moyer; Chapter 2 being assigned to Assessor Cywinski; Chapter 3 being assigned to Assessor McGarr and Chapter 4 being split by all the assessors. While reviewing the files through PowerDMS prior to the on-site, any issues which arose were quickly and efficiently corrected by Sgt. Albright.

On the morning of the assessment, Tuesday, January 9th, 2024, the team proceeded to The Patton Township Police Department and arrived at 8:00 am. Upon arrival, we were quickly and professionally welcomed by Sgt. Albright. We were led to the library where there was plenty of light and space, and all necessary items were provided (power, WiFi information, etc.).

Prior to the station tour, the team briefly met to discuss any unresolved file issues, all of which were those observable standards which needed to be verified during the station tour. At approximately 8:10 a.m., the team began a tour of the facilities led by Sergeant Albright. A detailed tour sheet with a check list was provided which highlighted all the required observable standards and all questions were answered completely and to the team's satisfaction. The assessors were shown the patrol, records, training, temporary holding and vehicles by Sgt. Albright, the firearms by Sgt. Matthew Shupenko and the evidence room by evidence custodian, Sergeant Scott Stroud.

The facilities tour concluded at approximately 08:55 a.m. The team returned to the work room to review the files which needed to be verified during the station tour. Those files were then marked in compliance.

At approximately 9:00 a.m., Assessors McGarr and Moyer conducted a ride-along while Assessor Cywinski conducted an interview with Chief Jolley.

Following the ride-along, the team reconvened and confirmed that all the files which required adjustment or repair were completed and compliant.

An exit interview was subsequently conducted with Chief Jolley, Sgt. Albright and Township Manager, Amy Farkas. The exit interview concluded at approximately 10:30 a.m.

STANDARDS SUMMARY:

FINGERPRINT COMPLIANCE: 87.1%

Of the program's 139 standards, one hundred (100) were found immediately compliant, three (3) were returned for file maintenance, thirty-six (36) files were found Not Applicable by function, which was due to the agency not providing court security or being a college or university and not having cells.

FILE MAINTENANCE:

- 2.4.1(c) Proofs contained parking tickets. Compliance proved by adding traffic ordinance citations.
- 3.5.1 Proofs did not show qualified persons. Compliance proved by adding proofs that showed the respondents were qualified.
- 4.15.1 This standard was redacted. Compliance proved by making it an N/A standard.
- 4.16.1 Missing proofs. Compliance proved by adding a simple note.

STANDARDS WAIVER REVIEW:

The Patton Township Police Department did not have any request for waivers or extensions during this accreditation cycle.

LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE:

The Patton Township Police Department is a full time, full-service police agency providing professional services to its residents, businesses and those who are passing through the township. The Department is a professional police department that has dedicated quality service to its community. All departmental personnel follow through with the necessary objectives to maintain a high level of service and are obviously dedicated to the accreditation process. Members of the Department have embraced the accreditation process and have implemented the Pennsylvania Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission's standards as "best practices" for the agency.

RIDE-ALONG REPORTS:

Richard McGarr Ride Along Report:

On January 9, 2024, from 0900-1000 hours a ride-along was completed with Officer Matt Shupenko. Officer Shupenko was in full uniform and wearing soft body armor (demonstrating compliance with standards 1.8.1 and 2.1.3). He was also wearing a department-issued body-worn camera and portable radio (demonstrating compliance with standard 3.3.1). Prior to the ride-along, he conducted a pre-shift inspection of the fully marked patrol vehicle. The inspection included the rear seat/transport area and verifying that visual and audio emergency signals were in operating condition (demonstrating compliance with standards 2.1 and 2.5). The vehicle had a mobile radio and MDT which is used to communicate to Communications (demonstrating compliance with standard 3.3.1). Officer Shupenko has been employed as a full-time officer for the last 18 years and is currently assigned to 8- hour patrol 1500 -2300.

On this particular morning, there was a major snow storm taking place. We drove through various parts of the community they serve. The patrol area is a combination of residential areas and housing for Penn State University students. I was provided a tour of the Upper Shop/Wash Bay where large item storage and vehicle storage is located. I was also explained the lockdown procedure which complies with standards 3.6.2.

Officer Shupenko and I discussed accreditation. He understood accreditation and how it increases an agency's professionalism and creates higher standards for the agency to achieve. He understands that it creates uniformity across all aspects of the department. Officers operate with consistency to perform their functions. He further advised that accreditation teaches officers the correct way to police. We concluded the ride-along without any calls.

Cory Moyer Ride Along Report:

On Tuesday January 9, 2024, I participated in the on-site assessment of the Patton Township Police Department. As a part of this assessment, I did a ride-along with Officer Bradley Tuskovich. This ride-along began at approximately 0900 hours and it lasted approximately one half of an hour. The duration of the ride-along was shorter than normal because of adverse weather conditions. It was snowing heavily and there was already approximately four inches of snow on the ground with heavy accumulations expected.

Prior to beginning the ride-along, I observed Officer Tuskovich was wearing a department issued uniform with an external soft body armor carrier. Officer Tuskovich's uniform was clean and professional. Officer Tuskovich was operating a marked Dodge Durango SUV. The vehicle was fully equipped with the standard law enforcement equipment, including a WatchGuard mobile video data recorder (MVR). Officer Tuskovich was also wearing a WatchGuard body camera.

My first impression of Officer Tuskovich was a very positive one. Officer Tuskovich told me this ride-along was not his first with a PLEAC Assessor. He was very easy to talk to and he immediately began asking me questions about the accreditation program and what I needed to see as part of the assessment.

Officer Tuskovich told me he has been with the Patton Township Police Department for twelve years and he had previously worked for two smaller police departments prior to this one. In addition to his patrol duties, Officer Tuskovich is the department's school resource officer (SRO), and active shooter instructor and he is a member of the county-wide tactical response team (TRT). Officer Tuskovich and I discussed how the training requirements of accreditation fit into what his department does with regards to active shooter and TRT training.

I learned the Patton Township Police Department works closely with the Ferguson Township Police Department. Officer Tuskovich told me that when officers are sworn in for the Patton Township Police Department, they also take an oath for the Ferguson Township Police

Department and new Ferguson Township Police Officers take an oath for the Patton Township Police Department. Officer Tuskovich said this is done because the departments work so closely together, and it makes it easier when it comes to providing assistance between jurisdictions.

At 0914 hours, Officer Tuskovich located an unoccupied abandoned vehicle that was stuck in the snow. Officer Tuskovich approached the vehicle and utilized county communications putting himself on scene. He located the owner/operator of the vehicle and assisted her by pushing the vehicle out of the snow. From my observation of Officer Tuskovich's interaction with the owner/operator, he was very courteous and professional.

Throughout the ride-along, Officer Tuskovich showed me various parts of the Patton Township Police Department's coverage area to include residential neighborhoods, student housing complexes (Penn State University) and commercial properties.

SUMMARY:

The Patton Township Police Department sets an example that should be emulated by other law enforcement agencies. Their organizational philosophies and practices show their continuing commitment to providing superior quality law enforcement services to their community. They demonstrated that the Department is well disciplined, well trained, well organized, and well directed. This was repeatedly confirmed by our observations and interactions with departmental personnel.
